Course Objective:

Students will learn essential financial skills, especially investing, and develop an understanding of how they can invest in the stock market.

- Day 1

- Day 3
 - Learn about the stocks they can invest in.
- Day 4
 - Learn about ETFs, and how they differ from stocks. Examples of common ETFs will be discussed
- Day 5
 - Learn different investing methods, mainly lump sum investing and dollar cost averaging.
 - At the end of the lesson, develop an understanding of what investment method to use
- Day 6
 - Review an investment portfolio to analyze and ask questions
 - Play a review game covering all of the material of the course for a prize at the end
